

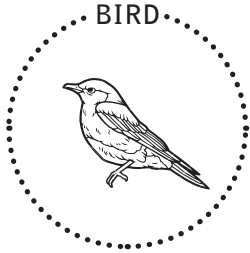


I SPY: FIELD NOTES
