ABOUT CARAMOOR

Located in Katonah, NY in northern Westchester, Caramoor Center for Music and the Arts, Inc. is a 501c3 non-profit arts center founded in 1946. Its mission is to enrich the lives of audiences through innovative and diverse musical performances of the highest quality, mentor young professional musicians, and engage children through interactive, educational experiences that deepen their relationship to and understanding of music. A wide variety of music is presented including classical, jazz, American roots, world, American songbook, family programs, and more. Caramoor also has a permanent and rotating collection of sound art installed throughout the property.

JAZZ AT CARAMOOR

Jazz has been included in Caramoor's programming since 1988, beginning with performances by the great Ray Brown and later by the Count Basie and Duke Ellington bands. The annual Caramoor Jazz Festival has been going since 1994.

Caramoor has collaborated on its jazz programming since 2015 with Jazz at Lincoln Center. This fruitful partnership has brought jazz legends McCoy Tyner, Chick Corea, Dianne Reeves, Wynton Marsalis and Eddie Palmieri to Caramoor, as well as introducing audiences to artists early in their careers such as Matthew Whitaker, Cecile McLorin Salvant, Jon Batiste, Aaron Diehl and Samara Joy.

The two organizations believe that music can elevate the quality of human engagement for individuals, social networks and cultural institutions throughout the world.

Caramoor's annual all-day Jazz Festival has provided a wonderful platform to showcase young talent and up-and-coming artists.
